- 500,000+ Americans are homeless with approximately 63% of them staying in sheltered locations.*
- Domestic violence is the immediate cause of homelessness for women both with and without children. (National Alliance to End Homelessness)
- 3% increase in the one-night estimates of people experiencing homelessness between 2018 and 2019
- 25% of America's homeless adults are employed. (Urban Institute)
- 25% of all people experiencing homelessness in the U.S. are in either New York or Los Angeles.*
- Families make up three-quarters of the homeless shelter population.*
- Nearly 40,000 veterans are homeless across the US on any given night.*
